

Carter Hargrave Anti Bullying Program Incident Form Instructions

The form is relatively simple to fill out to keep a record of the incidents of bullying that is taking place. It is of utmost importance that a clear and complete record is made and preserved to protect the victim. These incident reports will be the center piece to your case against the bully, and without a record such as this it is merely your word against theirs. When it comes time to go to the authorities whether it is a school principal, school board, a company, police, or a court judge, your records that are in order, with all the dates, times, along with copies, printouts, pictures, and reports, will insure that you will not only be taken seriously, but that justice will be served, along with getting the victims life back to normal.

Organization is the key. Make copies of everything. Always keep originals. And never give up. In the end if you follow the program you will find justice and peace.

The downside is that many states do not have adequate laws on the books regarding the internet and almost nothing in regard to bullying at all. The more information you can record and give to the authorities the greater chance of success. When presenting evidence always stay calm, don't get upset, and listen and follow instructions if given, especially in front of a judge.

Follow through after court. File all documents as required. Make copies. Keep copy of orders with you, or a picture or file (PDF) on your phone to show law enforcement when needed. Police will most likely not have easy access to any restraining or protective orders in the field. If you don't have room or don't understand how to do it, just download the dropbox file storage app in the app store. You can then access all sorts of files and pictures anywhere you are. Its easy so just do it.
